Q: Can you confirm some information about the back of the house card system and card purchases? First, who owns the current POS system?

A: Peru State College will retain the hardware.

Q: If the college owns the system, can it be deployed and used by the next vendor?

A: Yes, the provider would need to work with 1FITT Technology to set up their contract for software support.

Q: Who is the vendor for the campus card system?

A: 1FITT Technology is the software provider.

Q: How do you get dishes upstairs?

A: We utilize the dumbwaiter.

Q: Are there architectural renderings for the student center project yet?

A: No, the process is just starting.

Q: What is the timeline for the student center project?

A: Our goal is to have a plan by our April 2024 Board of Trustees meeting. We already have some reserves for this project, the April Board meeting will identify additional funding.

Q: What are priorities for the remodel?

A: The initial group just met on 10/10/2023 to start the process. Developing the order of importance in the next few weeks. For food service, our top priorities are HVAC and the Kitchen.

Q: How often do you use the whole dining facility?

A: 4 to 5 times a year, often for dinner.

Q: Is there a dock area and where is it located?

A: There is no dock area at the student center. There is a loading space on the southwest corner of the Student Center. If a loading dock is needed on occasion, there is one available at Facility Services

Q: Is the kitchen equipment in good working order?

A: Yes
